## **Stanisław Bóbr-Tylingo & Stanisław Swianiewicz**

A Polish resistance fighter and a survivor of the Katyn Massacre, Stanisław Bóbr-Tylingo and Stanisław Swianiewicz were exiles from their homeland. Highly decorated for their actions in war, and lauded for their academic achievements, they became professors in History and in Economics at Saint Mary's University. Their remarkable stories are the subject of this lecture by Dr. Joanna Pylat.



## **Dr. Joanna K. Pylat**

Born in Słupsk, Pomerania, Dr. Pylat received her doctorate in history from the University of Szczecin. She is Assistant Director of the European Culture Institute at the Polish University Abroad (PUNO), and a research volunteer at the Polish Institute and Sikorski Museum, London.
